The Houston Chapter of the American Petroleum Institute is pleased to announce the **11<sup>th</sup> Annual API Houston Three Gun Challenge**. This year's event will benefit the endowed engineering scholarships at five Texas universities as well as the Offshore Energy Center, The Houston Regional Science Fair, and other educational projects.

The event will take place, rain or shine, on **Monday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at American Shooting Center** in Houston, Texas. First flight registration starts at 6:30 am and competition starts at 8:00 am. Second flight registration starts at 11:30 and competition starts at 1pm. **The Mandatory Safety Briefing will start 30 minutes before each competition** start time and you must attend the briefing to participate in the event.

The Three Gun Challenge will include fun and challenging stages shot with a semi-auto pistol, shotgun, and rifle. The pistol caliber must be 9mm or larger, the rifle caliber must be .223/5.56 or larger and the shotgun will be gauge of choice. All participants must provide their own firearms and ammunition. Additional details on the event format and complete rules will be provided to event registrants.

**The event will be limited to thirty-six (36) 5-person teams and applications will be accepted in the order received by post mark.** The cost per team is \$1,200 which includes team entry, one prize gun per team, food, and entry gifts. All team TBA's must be turned in by February 15<sup>th</sup>. Golf cart rental is available through American Shooting Center by contacting Jeani Duke at (281) 556-8086.
