(Afternoon flight drawing for “shooter number” to determine door prize winners as well as any completed “squares” awards is scheduled to follow completion of the afternoon round; hopefully within 30 minutes)

RULES

- 1. All shooters must be API Houston Chapter members and at least eighteen (18) years of age.**
- 2. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the premises.**
- 3. Guns must be unloaded except in shooter’s box.**
- 4. All actions must be left open unless shooting.**
- 5. Hearing and eye protection are mandatory, including spectators.**
- 6. Score is final when shooter leaves stand.**
- 7. Ties for the Team event will be settled by scorecard shoot-off.
Best team score from a randomly chosen station.
A scorecard shoot-off will be held for ties in the HOA event for each course. HOA will be awarded on each of the courses for both a.m. and p.m. rounds.**
- 8. Only 2 ¾" Shells with a maximum shot size of 7 ½ allowed.**
- 9. Only four-wheel vehicles with bench style seats will be allowed on the course.
(Golf carts and mule-type units)**

FORMAT FOR 2010 EVENT

The API 2010 event will be a team event with five shooters per team. This is a 100-bird event held on three (3) x ten (10) station courses at American Shooting Center. These three (3) courses will be designed with a similar degree of difficulty.

Prizes will be awarded for the following achievements on each of the three courses and for each Flight (a.m. and p.m.):

- 1.) High Overall Combined Team Score**
- 2.) High Overall Individual Score**

In order to improve the flow of the event and minimize delays, scores may not be tabulated at the event. Final Scores and Prize recipients will be posted on the API web site (www.api-houston.org) within two (2) weeks.
